- You need to have acquired 30 Honor points by Tuesday, November 28, 2017. There will be no late acceptations.
- Meetings will continue to be held within the MP room (Starting November the meetings will be held within the black box theatre!!!)
- NHS contracts have been passed out. If you weren't at the meeting and didn't get one go to Ms. Lesar's room (D118) to pick one up, and have it signed on or before the next meeting (October 10, 2017)
 - For just signing the contract you will receive an honor point, however, not turning in the contract on time will result in the loss of honor points.

Service Opportunities:

- In order to get your honor points when going to an event make sure to take TWO pictures when you are at the event: One when you arrive with a time stamp and another when you leave with a time stamp!
 - **Or** if an officer is there, sign in with them and sign out!
- Get an extra honor point whenever you reflect on an event during the meetings.
- Free Rice and Pull Tabs are extremely easy ways to earn honor points
 - For Free Rice, gain 1 hp for every 1,000 grains of rice with a max of 5 hp.
 - For Pull Tabs, gain 1 hp for every 50 pull tabs with a max of 5 hp.
