2. Approval of 4-22-20 Minutes	Following a review of the April 22, 2020 Minutes, <i>J. Edom made a motion, C. McNerney seconded the motion, and council members unanimously passed to approve the April 22, 2020 Minutes as presented.</i>
3. Updated 2020-21 LCAP Discussion	J. Keyport shared the only change made to the previously reviewed 2020-21 LCAP was to Item 1.4 to increase the percentage of students completing the CTE Pathways. It was noted that changes may need to be made based on the status of the budget and dependence on Federal stimulus funding in August and September.
4. Vote on 2020-21 LCAP	<i>J. Edom made a motion, N. Hill seconded the motion, and council members unanimously passed to approve the 2020-21 LCAP with the change made to 1.4 as presented.</i>
