Thank you for your interest in CSF. To qualify, you must a) have taken rigorous course work and excelled in it, b) be able to garner at least 10 CSF points in no more than 5 courses, and c) complete the CSF application. To be a sealbearer you must qualify for 4 of 6 eligible semesters (sophomore through senior). To be a 100% member you must complete all 6 eligible semesters. You are also encouraged to participate in CSF activities throughout the year.

This application is for Spring semester, 2017 grades, and is open to juniors and seniors.

This is the application. Please print neatly so I can read it!

CSF not only looks very good on your college application, but can qualify you for scholarships that non-CSF graduates cannot apply for. Plus, you get a special gold stole to wear at graduation if you have at least 4 qualifying semesters, along with a pin and a gold seal for your diploma.
